Task One: This week please practise the following phonemes s, a, t, p, i, n, m and d. Your child will know that a phoneme is the smallest unit of sound that they can hear. Please refer to the sound as a phoneme. Enclosed you will also find two tricky words that we have been working on together this week, **I** and **the**. Your child will know that with the words being 'tricky' they are not able to sound them out. Play games together and ask your child if they are able to say any words with the sounds in for example - **in**, **at**, **is**, **it** and **am**.

Task Two/Challenge: Can you draw a picture of something you love to do? Can you think of a sentence with your adult to go with your picture? Remember to use one or both of the tricky words. For example 'I like to go to **the** park'. Please return this homework by **Wednesday 14th October**.
