



<p>Palm Sunday</p> <p>Liturgical colour: red</p>	<p>Mark 11:1-10 OR John 12:12-16</p> <p><i>Jesus rides a donkey into Jerusalem</i></p>	<p>Watch: Jesus rides a donkey into Jerusalem</p> <p>Do: Handprint palms or palm cut-out crosses</p> <p>Eat: Palm Sundaes</p>	<p><i>A Palm Sunday Craft</i></p> <p>Easy to make Hosanna Branch Wavers.</p>
<p>Monday of Holy Week</p> <p>Liturgical colour: purple</p>	<p>John 12:1-11</p> <p><i>Martha wipes the feet of Jesus with her hair</i></p>	<p>Watch: Mary wipes the feet of Jesus</p> <p>Do: Anoint Jesus' Feet Craft</p> <p>Eat: Lenten pretzels</p>	<p>I can show my love for Jesus.</p> <p>Use one paper for each student. Students should cut on the dotted line. Materials may include the oil jar. Press out on the bottle. Attach the bottle to the stick with the hair with a band when the bottle is finished as students can simulate pouring oil perfume on Jesus' feet. <p>Tuesday of Holy Week</p> <p>Liturgical colour: purple</p>	<p>John 13:21-33, 36-38</p> <p><i>Jesus tells Judas and Peter they will betray him</i></p>	<p>Watch: Jesus tells Judas he will betray him</p> <p>Do: Rooster colour by number activity</p> <p>Eat: Your favourite chicken dish (for the cockerel in today's Gospel)</p>	<p>BibleTime <i>I Don't Know Him</i></p> <p>Luke 22:54-62</p> <p>At the last supper Peter professed his love for Jesus. But later he denied knowing Jesus three times. What farm animal reminded Peter of his lies?</p> <p>Use the color code to find out: 1=Green 2=Blue 3=Yellow 4=Orange 5=Brown 6=Black 7=Red</p>
<p>Spy Wednesday</p> <p>Liturgical colour: purple</p>	<p>Matthew 26:14-25</p> <p><i>Judas betrays Jesus</i></p>	<p>Watch: Judas betrays Jesus (Start-1:20)</p> <p>Do: 30 pieces of silver hunt (think about who wins/who felt jealous about not winning. Compare this to the jealousy Judas felt. How can we use our coins for good? Donating to charity etc.)</p> <p>Eat: The coins from the silver hunt, reflecting on how we can use our money for good</p>	

<p>Maundy Thursday</p> <p>Liturgical colour: white</p>	<p>John 13:1-15</p> <p><i>Jesus' perfect example of love</i></p>	<p>Watch: Jesus washes his disciples' feet</p> <p>Do: Decorate Last Supper chalices with Easter symbols</p> <p>Eat: Unleavened bread and grapes</p>	
<p>Good Friday</p> <p>Liturgical colour: red</p>	<p>John 18:1-19:42</p> <p><i>The Passion of Jesus Christ</i></p>	<p>Watch: Jesus' Crucifixion (1:20-4:06)</p> <p>Do: Find or make symbols for each Station of the Cross</p> <p>Eat: Crown of thorn crackers</p>	
<p>Holy Saturday</p> <p>Liturgical colour: purple</p>	<p>Mark 16:1-8</p> <p><i>The women see the empty tomb and know Jesus has risen from the dead</i></p>	<p>Watch: Jesus' Resurrection (4:06-end)</p> <p>Do: Resurrection garden</p> <p>Eat: Hot cross buns</p>	<p>HOW TO MAKE A Resurrection Garden</p>  <p>Catholic Living</p>
<p>Easter Sunday</p> <p>Liturgical colour: white</p>	<p>John 20:1-9</p> <p><i>The disciples see the empty tomb and know Jesus has risen from the dead</i></p>	<p>Watch: Song - Jesus Christ is Lord</p> <p>Do: Painting the rolled away tombstone rock</p> <p>Eat: Easter eggs decorated with Resurrection symbols</p>
