Teachers will use a range of rewards to celebrate pupil achievements, these will include:

- ✓ A small treat
- ✓ House Team Points

Teachers may also send children to see Mrs Brown or Mr Joyeux with good work or to celebrate good behaviour, who may give them a special reward to recognise behaviour above or beyond the expectations. A warning will be given following as a reminder of our expectations:

Further Warning

As above and not responding to warning from adult.

Consequence

Not responding to reminders and warnings. Consequence to be given.
 Serious unacceptable behaviour will be moved straight to consequence.

Outstanding behaviour

Children who demonstrate **Outstanding Behaviour** are given a small treat from the class treat box and 10 house points.

At the start of **each learning session** in the morning and the afternoon, the children begin on **Green**. We expect the children to meet our expectations and follow our school rules.
