**LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR ANNUAL HOLIDAY The Education (Pupil Registration)
(England) Regulations 2006**

Amendments to the 2006 Regulations remove references to family holiday and extended leave as well as the statutory threshold of ten school days. The amendments make clear that Head teachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. Headteachers should determine the number of days a child can be away from school if the leave is granted.

Please do not book your holiday during term time or until you have requested authorisation. NPCAT attendance team is monitoring all attendance and punctuality issues alongside school.

School uniform:

The children look extremely smart in their uniform., particularly the new PE kit. Thank you for your support with this. It ensures that standards remain high and pupils, as always, reflect these standards. If you have any queries regarding uniform or the PE uniform, please do not hesitate to get in touch with school.

Just a reminder that the wearing of jewellery by pupils, including earrings, is not permitted due to health and safety reasons, this is school and NPCAT policy.
