#### Be Still & Know

**Year 1:** Recognising Jesus as the Son of God through his ministry; knowing the story of the last week of Jesus' life, his death and resurrection

Year 2: Who Jesus is and the nature of God revealed in miracles and parables; Lent as a time of reconciliation, Holy Week and the forgiveness shown at the Crucifixion

**Year 3:** God's kingdom told through miracles and parables; the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper

Year 4: "Who do you say I am?" and the Kingdom of Heaven brought to those on the edge of society; reconciliation and how devotion to God leads a person to do good works

# <u>Summer</u>

## Be Still & Know

**Year 1:** Pentecost, the Holy Spirit and the Glory Be; the Sign of the Cross, our local parish and aspects of modern Jewish life in Britain

**Year 2:** Ascension, Pentecost and the Holy Spirit; the Good Samaritan and some Jewish laws, beliefs and worship

**Year 3:** The Mass and how it mirrors Mass celebrated by the first disciples and the Trinity; Passover and some Islamic laws, beliefs and worship

**Year 4:** The narrative of St. Peter, building the kingdom of God and the role of clergy; St Paul, the Universal Church and the five pillars of Islam
