Firstly, I would like to thank all the parents who have taken the time to come and talk to me this term, it is only by working together that we can achieve great things here at St Hedda's.

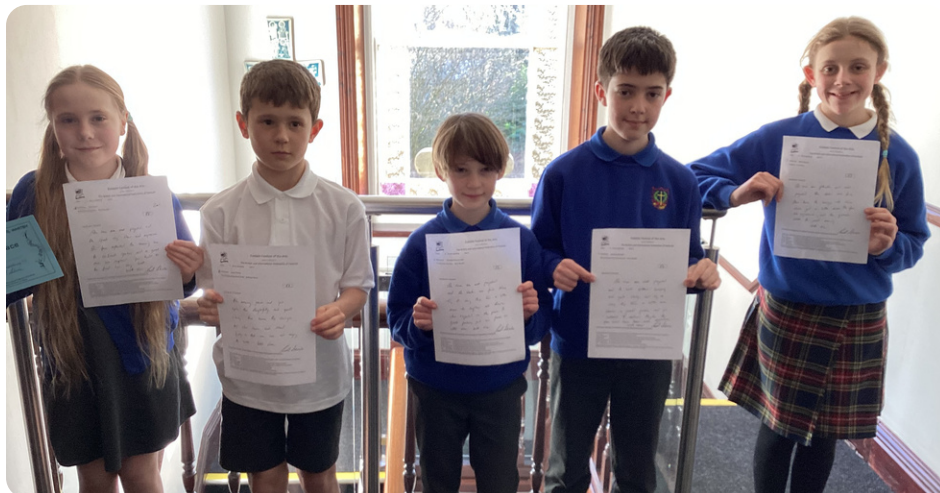
I would like to thank you for listening and the support you have shown the school.

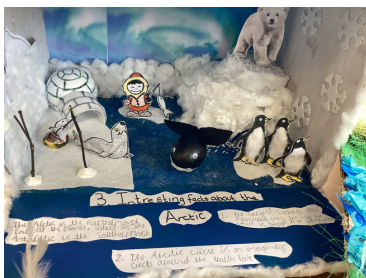

Class 2 Monday & Friday

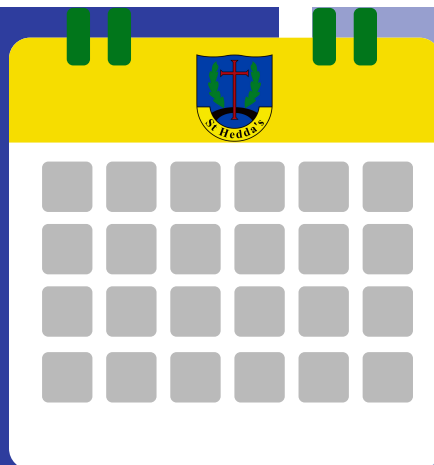
Mr Hill will teach PE each Monday
