In EYFS and Class 1 - This week we began the week with a service outside the church for Remembrance Day. The children were lovely and respectful during the service and Early Years laid a wreath which was made. We have started our DT project this week where the children enjoyed weaving through slots of paper. We learnt lots of new vocabulary and skills which we are excited to explore further.

Friday was a crazy hair day. We loved showing off our creative and crazy hair styles. We also enjoyed a fun dance workshop with Darcey Bussell, the children were amazing.

This week Early Years have enjoyed creating 'Helicopter Stories' using lots of new vocabulary to create stories. Early Years children have impressed us all with their phonics and blending skills this week. There has been super maths work this week too, lots of practical activities using objects to represent numbers.

In Class 2 - This week we took part in a Remembrance Service. The children made poppies and reflected on their meaning. We are really enjoying our History topic on Ancient Greece and are looking at changes throughout time. In science the year 3 and 4's have been looking at how some of our bones protect some of our vital organs. We also got to enjoy Dancing with Darcey, which was how the Royal Ballet has changed over time.
