In Class 1 - This week, Class 1 have been learning about the inside of a church and exploring the importance of the cross, we even went on a cross hunt around our school. In EYFS, the children have been listening to the traditional tale Little Red Riding Hood. We have been talking about the different characters in the story and discussing what each character does. The children enjoyed retelling parts of the story and sharing their favourite moments. The EYFS children have also been very busy making lots of wonderful picnics for Miss Dale to enjoy! Using their imagination and creativity, they prepared a variety of delicious pretend treats and worked together beautifully, showing excellent sharing and communication skills.

Year 1 have also been enjoying their English lessons, where they have been learning about poems, identifying rhyming words, and clapping out syllables in different words. The children have shown great enthusiasm and have enjoyed creating and performing their own rhymes. In Maths, Year 1 have been developing their understanding of fractions. They have been finding and recognising halves and quarters of shapes and objects, building their confidence through practical activities and problem-solving.

In Class 2 - This week, Class 2 have had a fantastic range of enriching experiences. In surfing, the children developed important water safety skills and even had the exciting opportunity to catch some waves. We also completed our sponsored swim, not only reaching but surpassing our target with an incredible total of 11,400 metres. Forest School has been full of creativity and exploration, with children building dens, making photo frames, and enjoying the outdoors with great enthusiasm. Our Year 5/6 pupils represented the school brilliantly at the Quad Kids event at Whitby School, showing excellent teamwork and determination. Looking ahead, we are excited to begin our new writing unit on newspaper reports, where we will continue to develop and showcase our fantastic writing skills.
