We have thoroughly enjoyed our surfing sessions this week, where we have learnt how to stay safe on the beach and how to carry out rescues in the sea. Some of us have even said we would like to become lifeguards in the future!

Year 6 visited St Paulinus in preparation for their trip next week, helping them to understand what to expect and build excitement for the experience ahead.
