The children have enjoyed sharing their knowledge, discussing key features such as having fur or hair, being warm-blooded, and how mammals feed their babies. Our play preparation has been in full swing, with lots of prop making, designing and problem-solving taking place. The children have used their imagination to create resources to bring their play ideas to life. Year 1 have continued developing their understanding of time, how to read a clock and how to tell the time using a clock.

In Class 2 - This week in Class 2 has been full of exciting events and memorable experiences. Our Year 6 pupils took part in Team Transition, where they joined with other Year 6 pupils from across the area and had the opportunity to meet new people and begin preparing for their move to secondary school.

We also enjoyed a fantastic surfing session, which was great fun for everyone and helped to cool us down in the warmer weather. Pupils showed enthusiasm, resilience and a willingness to try something new, with lots of smiles throughout the day.
