New School Year - September 2026

Following the summer holidays children return to school on Tuesday 8th September.

P.E. Days - 2026/2027

School Meals

From September our meal costs will remain the same at £2.80 per meal, this applies to children from Years 3 to 6. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are eligible for Universal free school meals. You may be entitled to receive free school meals if you are in receipt of certain benefits or support. Dinners are charged daily to your child's Parent Pay account.

School meals are provided by Caterlink and prepared daily on site by our school cook. Menus run on a 3 week cycle and the menu can be found on our school website. Children may request, on a daily basis, whether they would like a school meal or have brought a packed lunch.

Wraparound Care

Breakfast and After School Club costs:

Breakfast Club - 8.00 - 9.00 a.m. - £2.50 per session

After School Club - 3.15 - 5.00 p.m. (4.30pm Fridays) - £5.50 per session

Please remember these sessions need to be booked in advance by the Thursday for the following week and indicate approx. time of collection if you have booked for After School club. Thank you
