Please complete the key worker questionnaire which can be accessed via our School Website, Facebook and Twitter pages. This will assist in the planning of future provision for those children who have qualifying parents so it is important that this is completed as soon as possible.

It is extremely important that we are able to contact you whilst schools are closed. School must have an up to date contact phone number for parents/carers. Please contact the school office tomorrow if you need to update contact details.

Marvellous Me is an easy and efficient method for school to contact you. If you are not signed up, please contact the school office, you do miss out on information if you do not access this facility. Of course, Facebook and Twitter is used for some information.

Teachers are in the process of planning work and teaching children how to access work via Google Classrooms. Details of this will be sent to you tomorrow. Those who have responded to say you do not have access to computers and the internet will be provided with some paper based work. This again will be sent out tomorrow.

If your child is not in school to collect this work, you may need to make arrangements to collect home learning packs from school. If you and your family are self-isolating, you will have to make alternative arrangements for their collection. Obviously, anyone who we have registered as self-isolating will not be allowed on school premises.
