## **Arrangements for next week**

### **Key Worker Children**

Children in this group should arrive at the school office at 8.35am. They should be picked up at 3pm.

### **Y6 Children**

Our oldest children should line up at the school gate, you will see the ground has been marked out to ensure you keep 2m from others. Miss Ogden will meet Group 1 children there at 8.45 am. You will leave school at 3.10pm.

Mr Scarlett will meet Group 2 children at 9am, you will leave school at 3.15pm.

You should all have received notification of which group your child is in.

Y6 children are allowed to walk home if parents have signed a form. This has been updated for the Covid-19 pandemic, previous permission notes do not stand. Forms are available at the school office and are on our school website.

Y6 children can also bring a pencil case to include a pencil, ruler and coloured pencils.

### **Transport**

Our school minibuses will resume on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June, times for pick up and collection have been communicated to parents. Unless you have booked a place, your child cannot travel on the school bus next week.

### **All children**

School uniform should be worn by all children. Named water bottles need to be brought to school and taken home each day. Children do not need to bring anything else other than a packed lunch or dinner money.

Masks should not be worn by children, soap is available for use in school.

### **Home Learning**

As teachers will be needed to provide face-to-face teaching in school, it will not be possible to maintain the same level of remote education provision for pupils in the year groups who are not eligible to attend, or for those pupils in year groups who are eligible to attend but who themselves cannot(DFE Guidance).

From Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June, teachers in KS1 and KS2 will set work on a daily basis. This will include an English and Maths task. Teachers will not set more than 4 tasks each day. Children should, of course, be encouraged to read as much as possible!

EYFS teachers will continue to set work on a weekly basis as this seems to be working well.

Teachers will continue to use Google Classroom as a platform for this work. Paper copies can still be made available.
