Children will be in the school hall but will sit in their school bubbles and will not mix with children from other classes. They will be asked to wash their hands immediately upon entering the school building. Any resources used will be cleaned each day and breakfasts will be served at their tables.

We will run this next week and then assess whether any changes to systems need to be made.
