Carefully consider the risks of having a home firework display – the impact on the community (noise, animals, the environment and the additional burden on key workers like the emergency services and NHS A&E if things go wrong.

You can show your support for key workers by [downloading one of our colouring sheets](#) and putting in your window.

For those people who do have home displays:

- **Shop safely** – only buy CE marked fireworks from licensed premises
- **Keep a lid on it** – keep fireworks in a closed tin
- **Think don't drink** – alcohol and fireworks do not mix
- **Stay alert** – always supervise children around fireworks
- **Stand back** – never return to a lit firework
- **Stay legal** – don't buy via social media sites or residential homes

#### Wash hands

stay at least 2 metres apart - or 1 metre with a face covering or other precautions
