

1 homework point tasks

- Practice the 'Incy Wincy Spider' rhyme - can you make up some actions to go with the rhyme.
- Share a minibeast themed story with an adult.
- There are 9 ladybirds on a leaf. If 6 flew away, how many would be left on the leaf? You could use your fingers or draw a picture to help you.
- Draw a picture of your favourite minibeast.
- Act out the movements of a caterpillar, butterfly, grasshopper and spider.

- Take a walk around a garden, park or outside area. What minibeasts can you find? Look under plant pots and stones or on leaves and bushes. You could draw a picture or take a photo of any minibeasts you find.

- Create your own bird feeders to put in the garden so you can help care for our beautiful bird population.

3 homework point tasks

- Try making a model minibeast! You could use playdough or empty boxes, pots and tubes. Maybe you could create a beautiful butterfly, a wiggly worm or a scary spider.
- Use google to find out 3 interesting facts about your favourite minibeast.
- How do frogs grow? Draw a picture of each stage of the frog cycle.
- Can you create a symmetrical pattern on a butterfly template? Ask an adult to draw a simple design on one wing for you to copy.
- Using the letters in the word 'caterpillar,' what other words can you make?
