5 homework point tasks

- Go for a walk with a grown-up. What letters and numbers can you see on the number plates of parked cars? Can you see any letters of your name? Can you spot numbers 1 to 9?
- Make up a story with a grown-up about an adventure you could have in a hot-air balloon.
- Can you make a model of your favourite type of transport? You could use empty cardboard boxes or building bricks. What model will you make? You could make a car, bus, train or hot air balloon! We would love to see your creations.

By the end of the half term, you should aim for a minimum of 20 points.

3 homework point tasks

- Have you been on a bus ride? Where would you like to go on a bus? Tell a grown-up about a bus journey you would like to take.
- Think about a journey you often make. Can you draw a simple map showing some of the things you see on the journey?
- Make a boat with a grown up. Does it float?
- Talk to an adult about how to stay safe near the roads. You could make a road safety poster to show at school.
- Go on a journey with your family. It could be a short or long journey. It could be by foot, bike, car, bus or train.
