Our topic this half term is...

'Oh I do like to be beside the seaside'



Topic

Year 2 will be learning about holidays from the 1950s and 1960s, in particular seaside holidays. We will be thinking about how holidays have changed over recent years, what things are the still the same, what are different and the reasons why these changes have

happened.

As part of their collage topic in Art, children will be combining a range of materials that can be cut, torn and glued. To create a large seaside scene of Saltburn. We will also be studying Van Gogh and recreating some of his famous paintings.

In Music, the children will be listening and appraising rock songs this half term, as well as continuing to enjoy our singing lesson each Tuesday afternoon.

In Design and Technology, the children will looking at using textiles and templates. They will be designing and making their own puppet for a Punch and Judy show.

Maths

The children will be continuing to practise their multiplication and division skills focusing on 2s, 5s and 10 times tables. They will then move on to a statistics topic focusing on pictograms and block diagrams. Year 2 will then

work on length and height to end the half term.

The children will be continuing to practise their dance and gymnastics skills.



Computing

The children will be focusing on

questioning and graphs this half term. This will be done on Purplemash which they can also access at home.
