1 homework point tasks

- Research an animal whose habitat is in South America
- Write a diary of an imaginary trip to The Amazon Rainforest – what did you see, hear, feel etc
- Design your own Rainforest creature. Draw or make your animal and write a description of it. Think about: What it is like, where it lives, what it looks like, what it eats, who hunts it.
- Compose and perform a rainforest dance/ music.
- Create 'Did you know?' fact cards about the rainforest.
- Create a word search/ crossword puzzle using at least 12 rainforest keywords.

5 homework point tasks
