During this half term we will be exploring a range of books linked to many naturally occurring events and annual celebrations. We have begun with 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' by Michael Rosen and intend to go on our own bear hunt with FS1 at Kirkleatham Woods. Our visit to Kirkleatham is part of the Rambling Readers Challenge. Over the coming weeks we will also be taking part in activities that include Science Week, Spring, Pet Month and Easter. An Easter egg hunt may be in the pipeline for the end of term!



Physical Development

The children will be developing their fine and gross motor skills whilst planting vegetables and sunflowers in our outdoor area.



They will be creating houses from construction for their favourite animals and pets. In our sensory box there will be a host of mini breasts hidden amongst wood chippings. Throughout our daily routines we will continue to encourage independence.

Communication and Language

Some of our shared stories will involve repetition such as 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' and others will be picture books which will encourage curiosity and using new vocabulary. We will hopefully have our reading tent up and running which will allow the children another reading space. We will be using group time to practice listening skills through our environmental sounds Cd's.
