








Writing Overview - St. Joseph's 2021/22

As explained in the table below, each phase should be working on different purposes of writing.

In KS1, only 'To Entertain' and 'To Inform' should be taught. In LKS2, 'To Persuade' is then introduced before moving on to 'To Discuss' in the
