# HOME/SCHOOL AGREEMENT

- talk to you about any concerns we may have regarding your child's attitude, behaviour or work
- regularly mark and assess your child's work half termly to identify progress and next steps
- ensure your child understands their Reading, Writing and Maths targets
- invite you to termly Parents Evenings to discuss your child's progress
- send home annual reports
- seek your views about our school through regular parental surveys and act on findings
- offer parental support and advice through our Parent Support Advisor (PSA)
- invite you into school to join us for assemblies, mass and special events

- encourage and reward good behaviour and effort and teach pupils to take responsibility for inappropriate behaviour through the use of sanctions
