English	During the Spring Term, we will be using our geography and environment-based novel: The Explorer We will write persuasive letters, diary entries, newspaper reports, narrative chapters and information reports.	
Maths	Using Power Maths, we will cover place value, the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division), measures, algebra, fractions and geometry. We will also increase our speed and accuracy of mental maths including multiplication tables.	
RE	 The Y6 RE topics for the Spring Term are Local Church (Sources), Relating (Unity) and Lent (Death and New Life) Each topic looks in depth at a Big Question: Sources – Are books enriching? Unity – Why is it better to be united? Death & New Life –Can any good come out of loss and death? 	
Science	During the Spring Term we cover two science units: we learn about habitats, adaptation and evolution and about our bodies – digestion, circulation, blood, heart and lung.s	
History	Our first big question in history is How have children's lives changed in the last century? Our second topic is called Blitz . We learn about the WW2 in Middlesbrough and its impact on the people here and further afield.	
Art/ DT	Our first art work focuses around using watercolour skills. Our second art topic will be graphic design, creating propaganda posters and the images to illustrate the message.	
PE	Y6 will cover a range of sports allowing pupils to apply and develop a broader range of skills. Sports include tag rugby, sports hall athletics, hockey and dance.	
Music	In music, we will be extending knowledge of volume, pitch, timbre, dynamics and rhythm through listening to a variety of modern and older music.	
PSHE	Pupils will learn the importance of rules and laws and how they apply in our society.
