

When behaviour interrupts the learning of others...

Positive framing

30 seconds intervention - parents informed by class teacher

Reflection time, for the remainder of the lesson - parents informed and a meeting arranged, negative behaviour point

Recurring reflection time - parents informed and a meeting with Mrs Jones

One off serious incident or repeated reflection periods - at risk of exclusion, meeting with SLT

Behaviour concern - Inclusion meeting








