To raise awareness of this, children will be invited to start the week by taking part in Odd Socks Day. **All you need to do is wear odd socks!** It's a great way to celebrate what makes us all unique in Anti-Bullying Week! **Odd Socks Day is being held on Monday 14th November this year.** Odd Socks Day is delivered in partnership with CBeebies and CBBC star Andy Day and his band, Andy and the Odd Socks.

I am also pleased to tell you that we will be participating in the **NSPCC's Speak out. Stay safe.** online programme. This consists of an online assembly and supporting classroom based activities. **Speak out. Stay safe.** is a safeguarding programme available to all primary schools. It aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse in a child friendly way. Children are taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a trusted adult or Childline.

The NSPCC has studied the content of the materials and are extremely confident that they are appropriate for primary-school-aged children. By the end of the programme, we aim for children to feel empowered – knowing how they can speak out and stay safe.
