We are overjoyed to see how deeply our religious identity is rooted in our pupils' hearts. This term, we will continue to celebrate <i>"Fiat Mihi"</i> by highlighting pupils who "say yes" to helping others, taking on leadership roles and demonstrating exceptional kindness during our weekly assemblies.	Pupils have an excellent grasp of the fundamental British Values, with almost all children able to reel off <i>Democracy, Rule of Law, Liberty and Tolerance</i> .	We will continue to weave British Values naturally through our history, PSHE and RE curriculums.
While the vast majority of pupils described school behaviour as <i>Exceptional, Respectful</i> or <i>Good</i> a small number of older pupils noted instances of low-level disruption or listening issues in class.	Our behaviour management procedures are trauma-informed and focus on understanding the needs of every child. Our school rules of <i>Ready, Respectful and Safe</i> will be revisited with the children at the start of the term. Furthermore, staff will work together on reviewing our behaviour management procedures to ensure they are applied consistently by all staff across every classroom.	Children showed an incredible awareness of our rewards systems, enthusiastically listing everything from the <i>Star Box</i> and <i>Thrive Points</i> to the <i>Spirit of St. Mary's</i> .	It is clear these positive reinforcements are working wonders! Next year, we are looking at standardising how <i>Thrive Points</i> are celebrated weekly so that the excitement remains consistent across every single year group.
Pupils spoke with immense pride and clarity about how bullying is dealt with quickly (<i>"Because when people are being bullied, it gets dealt with quickly"</i>).	This is a testament to our robust safeguarding and restorative practice systems.
