Black History Month

Study of the true life story of Henry's Freedom Box about the life of a slave in America during the 1800s. Explore the role of influence of people such as Harriet Tubman, Nelson Mandela and Martin Luther King in a whole school 'Stop and Think' day. Each class throughout the school will use cross curricular links to explore and discover more about the influential roles these and other black people changed the world for the better. Activities focusing on equality accumulating in whole school participation in 'Show Racism the Red Card'. This included research into what role the charity takes place and how we are all unique. Class 6 comprising will invite parents into class for a 'Stay and Pray' dedicated towards the theme of equality through diversity. The focus act of worship will be to look at how our differences make us all unique and enrich our school family. The class will then spend the morning with a local songwriter composing a song about equality through diversity. This will then concluded by holding a whole school assembly on the theme of 'Diversity Through Equality' with each class presenting they particular area of work. The assembly will finish with Class 6 singing their song to the rest of the school.
