Marvellous Minibeast

As we move into our Summer Term, we will be investigating our school environment for the tiniest beasts on our planet. We will be learning how minibeasts impact on our world and why they are so important. Our book focuses will be Bees: A Tiny Miracle, Mad about Minibeasts, What the Ladybird Heard and the amazing story of The Hungry Caterpillar. Our literacy will be influenced by the books we will read. We will be making booklets about Bees and creating the butterfly life cycle. We will paint minibeasts and creating epic mini beast houses. Our number and shape will be linked to minibeast patterns, butterfly symmetry and grouping.

Pirates and Superheroes

During our final term of EYFS we will focus on super stories and incredible pirates. The books we will focus on will be; Supertato, Juniper Jupiter, Goodnight Pirates and Pirates in the supermarket. To practise our literacy skills we will be creating, wanted posters to catch the Evil Pea, making treasure maps, role playing superheroes and their super powers. Our number and shape focus will be applying and consolidating all of our number and shape skills from the previous year.
