



## EVERY DAY COUNTS

As few as 19 missed days over the school year reduces your child's chances of success.  
Their SAT or GCSE results could drop by one grade across all subjects.

The expectation is for every child to be achieving at least 97% attendance at any one time  
throughout the school year.

This is the expected threshold for progress in learning that your child will make when  
correlated to their school attendance.
