

## EYFS Outdoor Activities

### Kick the Cup

An alphabet activity – ask the children to kick a ball into a set of cups that each have different letters on; can the children tell you the letter they have kicked over? **Challenge** – who could build a word from that letter?

### Maths 1:1 counting

Using different numbers – ask the children to go on a hunt around the garden to find as many objects to your given number. Check the children are counting carefully. **Challenge** – Who could add the different sets of numbers together to make your own number sentence?

### Flower & Leaf crowns

Using different flower petals and leaves from the garden – can you thread them onto a piece of string and make yourself a crown? **Challenge** – Who can make a repeating pattern with the colours AND the objects you have found?

### Chalk Fire Fighters

Draw a fire on the brick walls outside using chalk. Using the hosepipe can you wash the fire away? **Challenge** – Who can remember the emergency number we ring if we needed the Fire Service?

### Measure Nature

Can you collect some sticks out on your walk? When you get them home; put them in order of longest to shortest. **Challenge** – Who could use a ruler to measure the longest stick?

### Giant Bubbles

Using a hoola-hoop and a large tray – can you make BIG bubbles and chase them? **Challenge** – What could we add to the bubbles to make them a different colour? There are lots of different ways!

### Tricky Words

Can you chalk your tricky words on the fence or floor at home? How many can you remember by yourself? **Challenge** – Who could put those words into a sentence?
