Dear Parents & Carers,

As today is the last day of the half-term I would like to remind you of emergency contact details during the next week. These are listed on the school website home page which you can find by clicking here: https://stpaulinus.npcat.org.uk/

As a school we do need to know if any child tests positive for COVID 19 over half-term so that we can get in touch with Public Health England and take the appropriate actions. If a family member tests positive for COVID 19 we also need to know if the children are considered a close contact and will therefore need to isolate for 14 days.

Therefore, if you need to get in touch with the school please do. The school phone number will not be answered during half-term week and any messages left on the answerphone will not be checked until Monday 2nd November.

How to stop COVID-19 spreading
