



Dear Parents and Carers,

All children are expected to complete work whilst remote learning takes place during this lockdown. If your child becomes unwell while we are off school, then of course we would not expect them to complete the work. We experienced fantastic support during the long National Lockdown last year and hope to build on that going forward.

All work will be sent out between 8-9am on the day that the learning will take place. All children should submit work by 3.30pm where the teacher can give an appropriate amount of feedback. **Any work submitted after 3.30pm will be looked at the next day.**

Google Classroom is an online platform for student learning, which allows children to access work following their year group curriculum. Every child will be assigned their own log in for Google Classroom and class teachers will set work for each child on a daily basis. This work will comprise of a piece of Maths, Phonics, or English linked activity and a foundation subject activity (see the next page for a 'suggested' timetable of the day). It is very important that children complete each piece of work and submit this every day so that the class teacher can mark and assess their learning.

Google Meet may also be used to share a session with the children 'live' so that they are facilitated to learn in a variety of contexts. The school will follow the Trust's Policy regarding these sessions.

All children have been provided with their own student log in and have spent some time in school familiarising themselves with how to complete and submit work. No printing of learning is required, as children complete the work on the device in which they are using (Phone, Tablet, Laptop) and the platform is very easy to use. It is extremely important that we maintain routine and education for your child should this situation occur and so we therefore ask that if your child has any difficulties accessing any of the work at any time, please inform us as soon as possible using the pupil contact email address so that the class teacher can contact you to offer support.
