Dear parents,

The children have all settled into Year One brilliantly and we are all getting used to our new routines. I have included some information which details our learning and topic.

TOPIC

Our topic work focusses around the question, 'Where do I come from?' In Science we are learning about our five senses, and how to name and label the parts of the human body. We are also learning about the human life cycle from baby through to adult. We have an ongoing science topic of tree identification.

In History we will be learning about Florence Nightingale, where we will be looking at family trees. If you have some family photographs, which you could send in with your child, this would really help with their learning. In Design and Technology, we have started designing puppets, which we will make for a puppet show to retell the story of the 'Gruffalo'.

MATHS

In Maths we are using a Mastery maths approach to continue to develop our understanding of mathematical concepts linked to number and place value. We will be focussing on counting objects carefully, comparing objects, understanding greater than, less than and equal to. We will use our knowledge to help us problem solve and explain our answers.

Our P.E lessons are on a Monday and a Wednesday. Please can you send your child into school wearing their P.E kits on theses day. For this half term our Monday session is run by the sports coaches. During our Wednesday session we will be doing Yoga. Please can you ensure that your child has their hair tied back.
