Dear parents,

The children have enjoyed a great first half-term in Year One and have settled back in since our return after the October break .

## TOPIC

Our topic work focusses around the question, 'Which is the best material to make a toy?' In Science we are learning about materials and their properties. We will be exploring what familiar objects are made from and why. We have an ongoing science topic of tree identification.

In History we will be learning about traditional toys. We will be learning about changes in living memory by exploring toys throughout history and comparing them to modern day toys. Please talk to your child about your favourite toys and what other relatives used to enjoy too! In Design and Technology, we will be designing a toy that is suitable for a younger child to enjoy playing with, using our knowledge of materials to support this.

## **MATHS**

In Maths we are using a Mastery maths approach to continue to develop our understanding of mathematical concepts linked to additional and subtraction. We are using the part-whole model and bar model to help us understand the concept of addition. In addition to this, we are learning number bonds to 10. We use our knowledge to help us problem solve and explain our answers.

Our P.E lessons are on a Wednesday and Friday. Please can you send your child into school wearing their P.E kits on these days, including a jumper. Please can you ensure that your child has their hair tied back. Our P.E focusses this half term are Invasion Games skills and Gymnastics—balancing and spinning.
