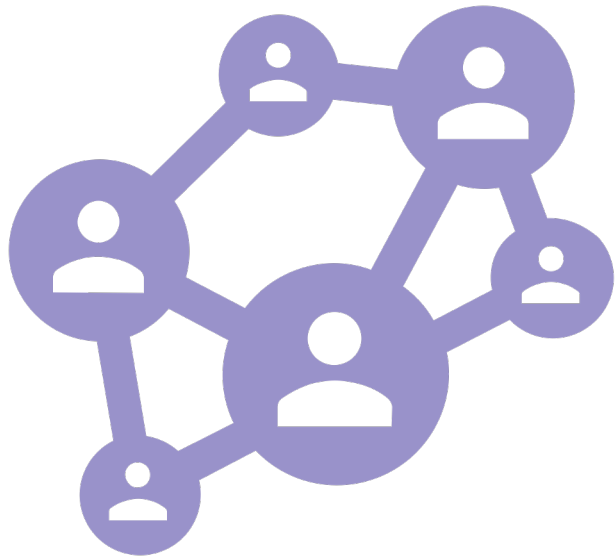
What is a “Zero Hero” ?

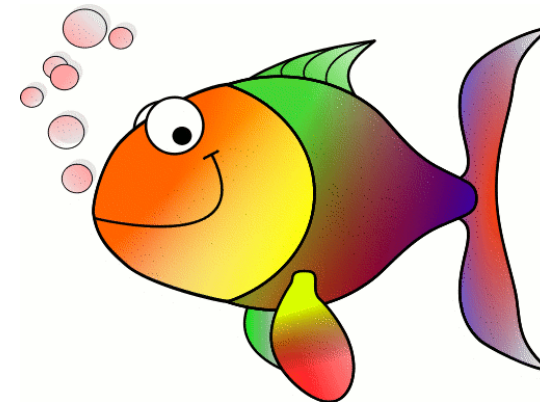

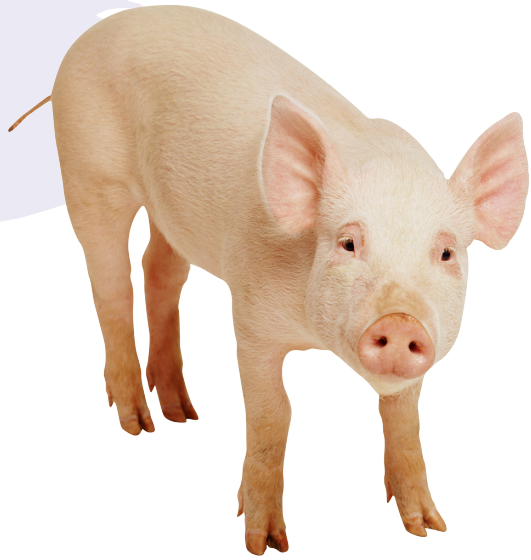
