Remote Learning Arrangements

The curriculum will continue to be delivered according to the timetable via **Live Lessons**.

All Live Lessons will be taught on Google Meet and students are expected to virtually attend all lessons on their school timetable.

Teachers will invite pupils to Live Lessons via Google Classroom.

Live streaming and pre-recorded lessons must only be for pupils on roll at the school.

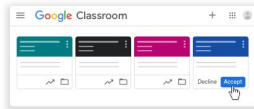


Select the Google Classrooms icon. You have been invited to an online class for every lesson. Click 'Accept'

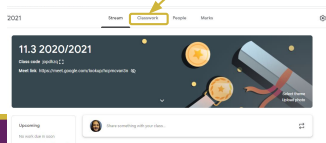

Attending a Live Lesson

Once you have accepted all invites, click on the subject on your timetable.



When in that Google Classroom, the link to the live lesson will appear in the stream on the front page and can be found under the classwork tab. It will be released 5-10 minutes before your lesson is scheduled to start.



During a Live Lesson

All notifications on your device should be turned off so as not to disrupt the lesson.

Expectations of how to answer questions will be set out at the beginning of a lesson.

Behaviour expectations remain the same as at school.

Cameras should be turned off during the lesson and microphones muted unless pupils are directed to unmute to answer questions or take part in discussions.

Time will be given to complete tasks and work during the lesson.

Work that is produced should be uploaded to Google Classroom at the end of the lesson for marking.
