Blazers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The wearing of a blazer is mandatory 	
Jumpers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wearing a jumper with school logo is optional 	
Trousers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils can wear plain formal black trousers A school logo is <u>not</u> necessary 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Skinny jeans/trousers/leggings/jeggings are not allowed Elastane/stretchy fitted trousers are not allowed on any day Students who arrive wearing these will be given formal trousers to change into or be sent home.
Skirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils can wear a plain black skirt A school logo is <u>not</u> necessary 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Elastane/stretchy fitted skirts are not allowed Skirts must not be rolled up and must not be above the knee Any other form of skirt is not allowed
Shirts and Blouses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A plain white shirt, with a fastening top button and full collar All garments worn under blouses/shirts must also be white Must be tucked into skirt or trousers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Coloured articles of clothing under shirts is not permitted. For example: coloured football tops or t-shirts, coloured sports bras and bras etc. T-shirts/vests etc. worn under shirts should be plain white.
School Bag	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must fit an A4 ring binder/A4 books Must be secure to protect contents with a zip etc. Must contain pencil case (including two pens, a pencil and ruler) and planner 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fashion bags that do not fit a ring binder and a pencil case.
Ties	Available from TeesValley Schoolwear and Rawcliffe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be worn covering the top button of the shirt collar and down to the waistband of the trousers or skirt

PE Uniform	<p>Available from TeesValley Schoolwear and Rawcliffe</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● School PE shirt ● School PE black shorts ● plain black sports socks ● optional hoodie available from Motif8 and Rawcliffe ● Students may continue to wear their current orange PE shirt and black shorts until they need replacing ● Students are expected to bring trainers for all lessons, or football boots when requested by the PE department ● Students are required to change for PE even if they are not fully participating for medical reasons 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No plimsolls or other leisure shoes are appropriate for P.E.
Jewellery		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No jewellery of any form is allowed ● Earrings are not acceptable even when covered ● No plastic posts or retainers
Watches	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Conventional analogue and digital watches are acceptable 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Watches with additional features including internet access, such as Apple and iWatches are not acceptable as they are treated under the mobile phones rule
Coats/Hoodies/Other Outdoor Clothing		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Must not be worn inside the academy building they must be removed outside for lining up (other than in poor weather)
Tights and socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Tights must be plain black at least 40 denier ● Black knee-high socks ● Black full-length socks 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Other colours or patterned tights are not permitted ● Over the knee socks are not permitted ● Coloured socks are not permitted
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Low heeled formal black shoes, without logo ● Shoes by Kickers are acceptable 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Trainers, plimsolls or any form of canvas shoe are not acceptable. ● Boots are not acceptable including Dr Martens, UGG Boots unless medical evidence is provided

Make up & Beauty Treatments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discrete, natural makeup 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nail varnish is not allowed False nails or false eyelashes are not allowed
Hair		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No patterns or designs shaven into head Hair dye in unnatural colours and other treatments of this nature are not allowed
Special Consideration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Items worn because of religious beliefs e.g. hijab must be plain black with a plain pin. Please enquire to the Headteacher about other queries of this nature 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No decorative pins are allowed
