As you are acutely aware all 26 schools within Nicholas Postgate Catholic Academy Trust -NPCAT remain open across Teesside and North Yorkshire providing continuous provision for the children of our Key Workers and all those identified by the government when the partial closure of schools was announced.

As a Trust we feel that it is vital that we maintain in contact with you throughout these challenging times and I hope you are appreciative of the ongoing communication from schools both to you as parents and also with all your children. The NPCAT term ends next **Thursday 9th April** and starts on **Monday 20th April**.
