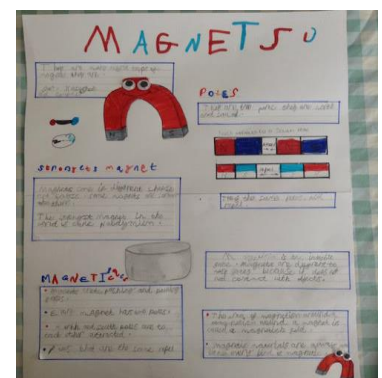
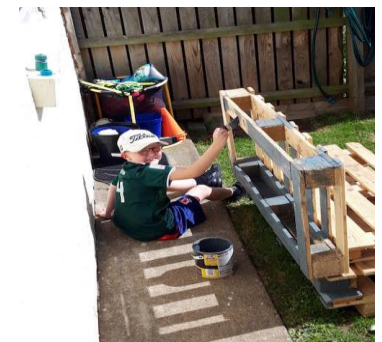

If you think there is a possibility that you are entitled to Free School Meals can you please obtain an application form from school and return it as soon as possible, alternatively Mrs Mackey, would be only be too happy to help you complete it if you wish.

We know that some of you are entitled but choose not to apply as your child prefers a packed lunch. If this is the case you should still apply and still bring your child in the meal of their choice. It is extremely important that all parents entitled apply. If you are claiming Income Support or Income based Job Seekers Allowance or, Child Tax (but not Working Tax Credit) and have an annual income which does not exceed £16,190, you are entitled to
