


## Parent Questionnaire Results November 2020

Conducted via Google Forms.


Since returning to school has your child settled into school life well and are they happy to come each day?




Do you feel your child is safe at our school?


Would you feel comfortable approaching school if you had a question or a problem?


Do you feel the children behave well at our school? 82 responses

Do you feel the school is well led and managed?





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
Do you believe staff expect your child to work hard and achieve their best?
