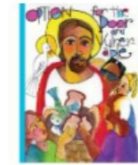

Wednesday 22nd October: Reception

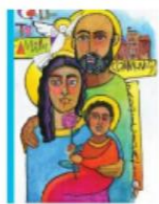


Macmillan Cake Sale
