16-19 Tuition Fund Statement

As a requirement to be eligible for the small group tuition funding from the ESFA, we are publishing the statement on how we intend to use the small group tuition funding allocated to Trinity Catholic College.

Students who require extra support, in order to achieve a 4 or above in maths or English are identified and allocated set periods in our achievement centre on our directed study programme. Our achievement centre is supported by an experienced member of staff, who will provide personalised, small group tuition on specific areas of the curriculum where students need extra focus. This tuition is in addition to the students timetabled lessons of GCSE maths or English.

Any leftover funding will also be allocated to the achievement centre, in order to provide the extra resource, to help students catch up on lost curriculum in other subject areas. This will also be provided in small groups and focus on subjects that students specifically need extra tuition and support with.

As a school, we will monitor the usage, spend and impact of the tuition fund for students. This will enable us to ensure we are using the fund in the most effective ways to help students catch up on lost learning and prepare for their examinations.
