

- 4. Knowledge retrieval
- 5. Year group related PSHE
- 6. Collective worship

The meeting will be led by senior members of staff and the content will focus on recalling prior knowledge so that pupils can embed knowledge into their long term memory to help them make even more progress in lessons. Moreover, pupils will lead and take part in quality collective worship every Friday. This is an opportunity for pupils and staff to reflect on the week and celebrate our God-given talents.
