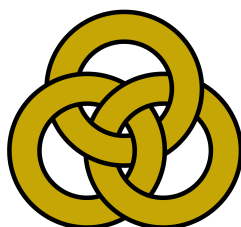

Standards and expectations

All pupils must return to school in full school uniform:

GIRLS UNIFORM

- Black tank top (optional) – no other jumpers/cardigans allowed.

- Plain black tights without pattern, socks white or black only

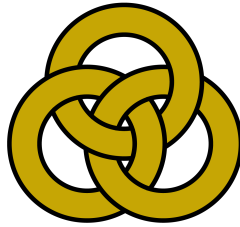

Students are required to bring the following pieces of equipment to school each day:

- School bag that fits an A4 folder
- Pen (and spare pen)
- Purple pen (feedback and corrections)
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Pencil case
- Rubber
- Pencil sharpener
- School planner (we will provide a new one for all pupils)

As a College we expect that a high standard of uniform and personal appearance is maintained at all times. Students are expected to wear their uniform with pride.

- Jewellery should not be worn in school (this includes body piercings).
- Extremes of hair style are not permitted, e.g. shaven, severe haircuts/colours, hair extensions, patterned/dyed etc. ***The decision on the severity of a haircut is at the school's discretion.***
- No decorative accessories; plain bobbles and hair bands only
- During cold weather coats to be worn outside only.
- Discrete make-up that looks natural. No false lashes. No painted or acrylic nails.

Shoes must be:

- Black shoes – polishable, not trainers or fashion shoes with logos (no stacked heels for safety purposes)
- Canvas shoes are not permitted

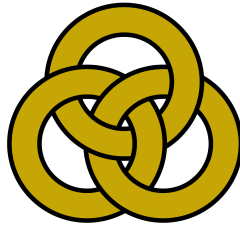
