- Record of achievement, encouragement and praise are extremely important in maximising a student's performance. Tier 2 and 3 awards are presented in achievement assemblies.
- A direct award at tier 3 is issued for a county or regional achievement.
- A national achievement entitles direct entry into the colleges' Achievement Record Book.
- All awards continue to count from year 7 through to year 11.
- All awards are kept in the students' personal Record of Achievement and Experience folder which is held by the group tutor.
