Assessment & Marking Protocol within Art Design and Technology

GCSE Folders and Key Stage 3 Topic Sheets

KS3 Practical is monitored continually during lessons and formally at the end of a block of work eg 8 lessons for DT and between 2 and 7 lessons for Art.

GCSE Engineering: Theory work monitored regularly during lessons & formal assessment at the end of each topic. Practical work is assessed at the end of a block of work 8-10 lessons.

GCSE Art and Photography: coursework continually monitored during lessons and formal assessment of tasks half termly.

Cambridge National Child development: Classwork assessed regularly and given feedback. End of module tests given to check understanding. Homework booklet assessed after every piece of work. Coursework regularly monitored and feedback given.

WJEC Hospitality and Catering: Theory work monitored regularly during lessons & formal assessment at the end of each topic. Each piece of practical work photographed and marked and filed in mark book. Written and verbal feedback provided.

Areas for improvement will be recorded using the What Went Well and Action Points procedure.

More specific 'real time' targets for improvement are identified during lessons & provided verbally due to the nature of the subject.

Assessment of Work at Key Stage 3 (Year 7, 8, 9)

All practical work will be graded from Emerging to Extending.

Classwork is monitored during lessons. DT: formal assessment takes place after the designing stage of a project and at the end of a project. ART: assessment of the formal elements and work inspired by other artists is assessed at varied times throughout the Key Stage to show progress.

At the end of each academic year every student has a formal end of year assessment which is graded from Emerging to Extending.
