

Assessment & Marking Protocol within **Physical Education and Dance**

GCSE/Cambridge National/BTEC PA Folders and Key Stage 3 Topic Sheets

KS3 Practical performance is monitored continually during lessons and formally at the end of a block of work, 8 lessons.

GCSE PE: Theory work monitored regularly during lessons & formal assessment at the end of each topic. Practical work is assessed at the end of a block of work 8-10 lessons.

BTEC and Cambridge National: Both theory and Practical work is monitored continually during lessons. Formal assessment will take place through the completion of the Assignment Tasks throughout any given unit. The examined units will be assessed at various points throughout the 120 GLH's.

Areas for improvement will be recorded using the What What Well and Action Points procedure.

More specific 'real time' targets for improvement are identified during lessons & provided verbally due to the nature of the subject.

Assessment of Work at Key Stage 3 (Year 7, 8, 9)

All practical work will be graded from Emerging to Extending.

Classwork is monitored during lessons. After each activity (8 lessons) work is self and teacher assessed.

A formal assessment will take place at the end of each block of work.

Homework is N/A

At the end of each academic year every students has a formal end of year assessment.

Assessment of Work at Key Stage 4 (GCSE/BTEC PA/ Cambridge National)

GCSE PE Graded 9-1

Classwork is monitored during lessons. Each half term classwork may be self, peer or teacher assessed.

A formal assessment will take place at the end of each topic. This is the case for both the theory and practical components of the course.

End of year/mock examination & repeated self evaluation will be conducted to assess progress over the year.

BTEC Performing Arts and Cambridge National in Sports Studies

Classwork is monitored during lessons.

Learning Objectives are internally assessed at the end of a Unit following the completion of assignments. Work is graded Level 2 Distinction * - Pass

Dedicated Improvement & Reflection Time (DIRT)

KS3 (After formal assessments)

Time after formal assessments where students respond to marking in a red pen and complete their topic sheets identifying WWW and AP

GCSE/BTEC PA/Cambridge National (after formal assessments):

Time after formal assessments where students respond to marking in a red pen (Theory)

Every day-to-day DIRT during lessons takes place, teachers and peers provide on the spot feedback and the student then responds to make progress.
