Dear Parent

We wrote to you back in May to confirm that your child's transition day would be Wednesday 7th July. We are now in a position to give further details concerning this.

Full Transition Day - Wednesday 7th July

Your child is invited into school at **8.30 am**. They should come to the school and enter the hall using the gate from the school drive. Members of staff will be on hand to direct and welcome your child into the building. We ask that your child walks into school; please **do not drive** onto the school site to drop them off. Your child will leave at **3.00 pm** from the same place they entered in the morning.

Your child should be in their primary school uniform, wearing trainers and bring with them a small named bag with a pen, pencil, ruler, a bottle of water and a snack if they wish for breaktime. On the day, your child will be provided with a complimentary school meal at lunchtime.

During this day, your child will participate in taster lessons including Maths, English, Science and PE as well as spending time with their tutor. This will be an opportunity to make new friends and get familiar with the surroundings of their new school.

Using the canteen

We thought we would take this opportunity to update you about how your child will be able to use the canteen in the Autumn term. So that they can buy food and drink, we will issue the children with a canteen account card on their first day at Oathall. These are proximity cards using the same kind of technology used for public transport systems. Your child's card will be linked to School Gateway, the online payment system which we use at Oathall. If your child is eligible for free school meals, the funds will automatically be added to their account every day. If you are new to using School Gateway, we will be in touch before the end of the summer term with details of how you can add funds to your child's school meals account.

New Parents Evening

We would like to invite you to a new parents evening on **Thursday 15th July from 6.30** - **7.35 pm.** The evening will include a presentation by key members of staff as well as an opportunity to meet your child's tutor and ask them any questions.

In order to keep numbers in the hall manageable, parents with children in **Pioneer & Voyager** houses will watch the presentation in the hall first and then go to meet their child's tutor in classrooms. Parents with children in **Discovery & Endeavour** houses will meet their tutor in classrooms first. They will then go to the hall to see the presentation. There will be students and staff on hand to direct you to the correct locations.

First day of school in September

Thursday 2nd September is an INSET day and therefore closed to students. On **Friday 3rd September**, we will have Year 7, 10 & 11 in school. Year 7 will be taught in their teaching groups and they will also have time in their tutor groups each day, led by their tutor.
