The COVID-19 Immunisation Service is coming into school on *11 February 2022* to offer your child COVID-19 Dose 1 (if they have not already had it) or Dose 2 vaccination.

Contained within this email is the following document:

A parent letter - with instructions on how to complete the online consent form, to either consent or refuse this course of vaccinations. This can be done via the following link and by following the instructions contained in the attached letter. <u>Vaccination Consent</u> (susseximmunisations.co.uk)

This letter also contains your school's unique Cinnamon school code, which you will need in order to submit your child's consent form. If you have more than one child but they do not attend the same school site, please do not submit the consent forms using the same code. You will receive a separate letter from your other child(ren)'s school(s) in order to consent for your other child(ren). This letter also contains important information on the vaccines and frequently asked questions, to help you and your child reach an informed decision regarding consent.

The online consent form is available for completion until I lam two working days before the session date above. If you have any difficulties completing this online form, please contact 01293 227797 before the cut-off date. If you miss the cut-off time to complete the consent form, we will not be able to vaccinate your child in school on the day of the vaccination session.

The consent form will reopen one working day after the session, enabling you to submit a form for your child to be offered the vaccination at a later date, from one of our catch-up clinics.
