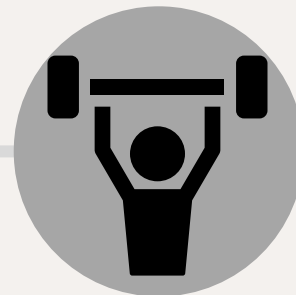
How you can demonstrate and develop the Oathall Values in an academic year

RESPECT



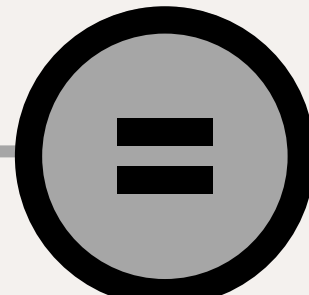
- Celebrating the achievement and progress of others.

RESILIENCE



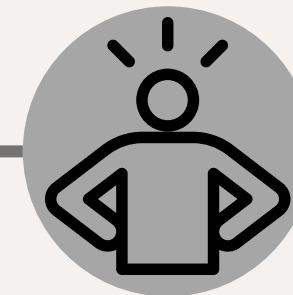
- To learn from mistakes during D.I.R.T and accept that mistakes are all part of the learning process.

EQUALITY



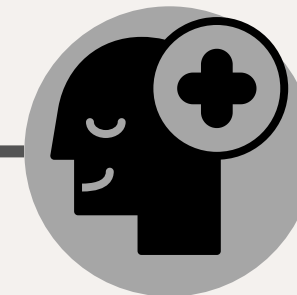
- Respect everyone's opinions.

CONFIDENCE



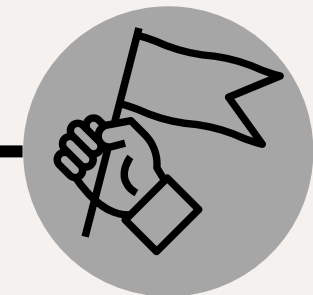
- Volunteer work to go under the visualiser to help everyone make progress.
